



Some twenty years ago, the late SWD President **Gary Keck** (founder of "The Train Shack" in Burbank, CA) came up with the idea of having a summer picnic, in place of

the August monthly trading Meet. The tradition of this great annual event at the Los Angeles Live Steamers in Griffith Park resumes for 2023 on Saturday, August 5th, after a three-year absence caused by the COVID-19 restrictions in Griffith Park. Although this is called a "Member Appreciation Party," SWD members are encouraged to invite friends, family and neighbors to this fun annual When last held on August 3, 2019, we had over 300 adults and children in attendance.



Due to inflation, we are forced to raise the cost for adults and children 12 and over to \$8.00, which is a \$1 increase from 2019. (Children under 12 are free.) Considering what restaurants are currently charging, \$8.00 is a bargain, and attendees get unlimited seconds as long as the food lasts. The admission fee also covers our \$500 donation to LALS.



This year, for the first time in many years, we are scheduled to be running two live steam locomotives at the head of our trains. These are pictured in here, and are Pennsylvania #4561 a 2-10-0 "Decapod" and the Heisler #5, a remarkable

geared locomotive, similar to a Shay. Don Kallgren, an LALS/SWD dual member, is working very hard to line up locomotives and the volunteers to run them. The trains are scheduled to start running at 11:00 am and the last train leaves the station at 2:30 pm.

We try to have a variety of food that will satisfy everyone's requirements: all-beef hamburger patties, 6" Hebrew National hot dogs, vegetarian Garden Burgers, fresh tomatoes, shredded lettuce, onion chips,


The SWD Officers and Board Members work very hard without compensation of any kind to make our club the success it has become.


