

## SWD President's Message, continued...

We made a \$500 donation to the LA Live Steamers, which was very much appreciated. They consider us to be the "Gold Star" picnic at their facility, because we are well behaved and always leave the place cleaner than we found it. Financially, we hoped to break even, and we did.



I am sad to report that the Toy Train Operating Society Board of Directors met at the 2023 National Convention in Columbus, Ohio in August and voted to terminate the National Club as of December 31, 2023. National had its beginning in 1966 and has been in continuous operation for 56 years. As a result, starting in January, 2024, the 13 active Divisions can continue to operate, but will do so independently.



The most immediate issue is that the existing Board of Directors is retiring at the end of the year and no one wants to take their place. The second issue is declining membership. The break even number for financial viability was set at 1500, and the current membership was at 1474 and dropping at the rate of 100 members per quarter.


