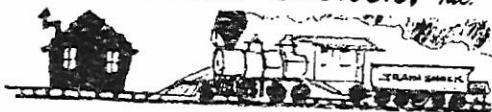

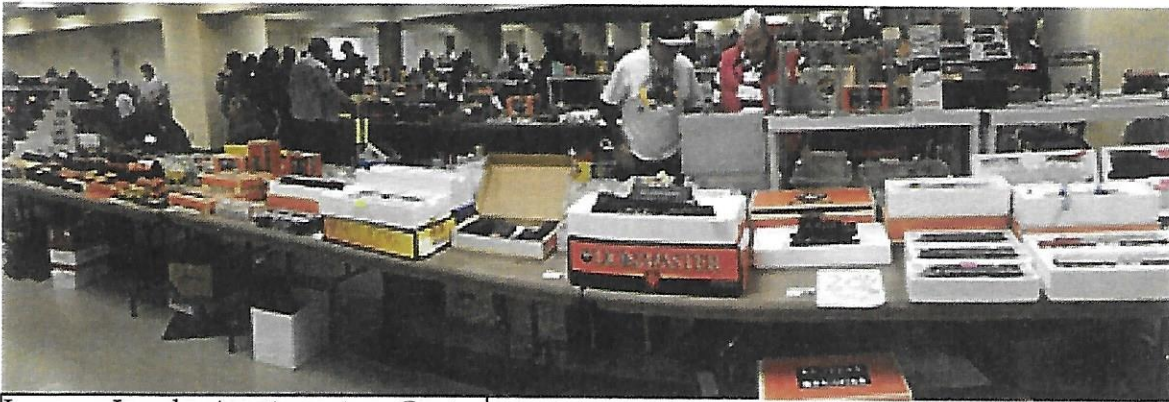

**United Methodist Church (Church of Good Shepherd)**


400 W Duarte Rd, Arcadia, CA 91007


