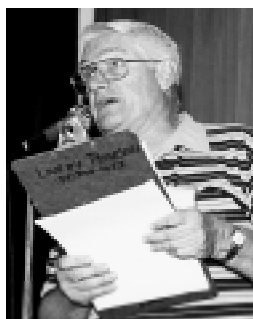

TTOS STICKERS FOR MARKING RESTORED TRAINS

The TTOS Standards Committee, headed by TTOS National Vice President **Randy Giroux**, has recently produced and distributed stickers, which must be affixed to all "restored" trains offered for sale at all TTOS Meets. These stickers must also be used on restored trains sold using "TTOS Membership" on internet auctions. These small round stickers will be available at the Registration table at our monthly Meets and at Cal-Stewart. A train is restored if "major" components (i.e. complete motor or cab) have been replaced or if the item has been repainted or re-marked. Wheel replacement or re-wiring is not considered to be "restoration". TCA stickers are acceptable at TTOS Meets. If you do not have stickers, you must plainly tag the item as being "restored".

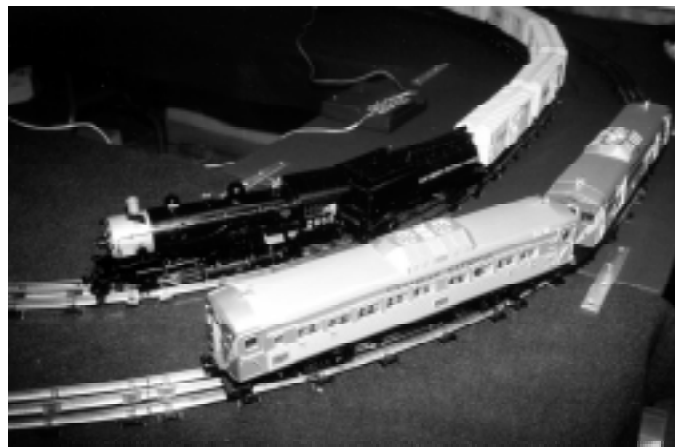
