If you'd like an additional car or just forgot to order one, here's the info. Bruce Lazarus will bring the cars to the July 14th T.T.O.S. Southwestern Division Meet. By picking up and paying for them at the Meet, you save the \$10 shipping charge!!! While prices are already rising on E-Bay, they aren't at the T.T.O.S. Southwestern Division Meet. With only 3 O Gauge and 12 S Gauge cars left, these should sell out. All the cars are Mint in the box.

If you want to pre-reserve one of these cars for pickup at the July 14th Meet, call Bruce Lazarus at 818-225-1710. Otherwise, it's first come, first served for what's left at the Meet. The original pricing is still in effect. (note that California's Sale Tax Rate has increased to 9.0%), as listed below:

Lionel O-gauge LifeSavers® Wint O Green Tank Car @ \$61.95 each plus California Sales Tax of \$5.58. Total= \$67.53 per car – We'll round that off to \$67.00 and SWD will absorb the difference, so that you don't have to bring change.

We have ONE American Flyer S Gauge LifeSavers® Wint O Green Tank Car left. Also at the original price of \$62.95. Add \$5.67 Sales Tax for a total of \$68.62, which we'll also round off to \$68.00.

Remember.....First come, first served until we run out of cars.

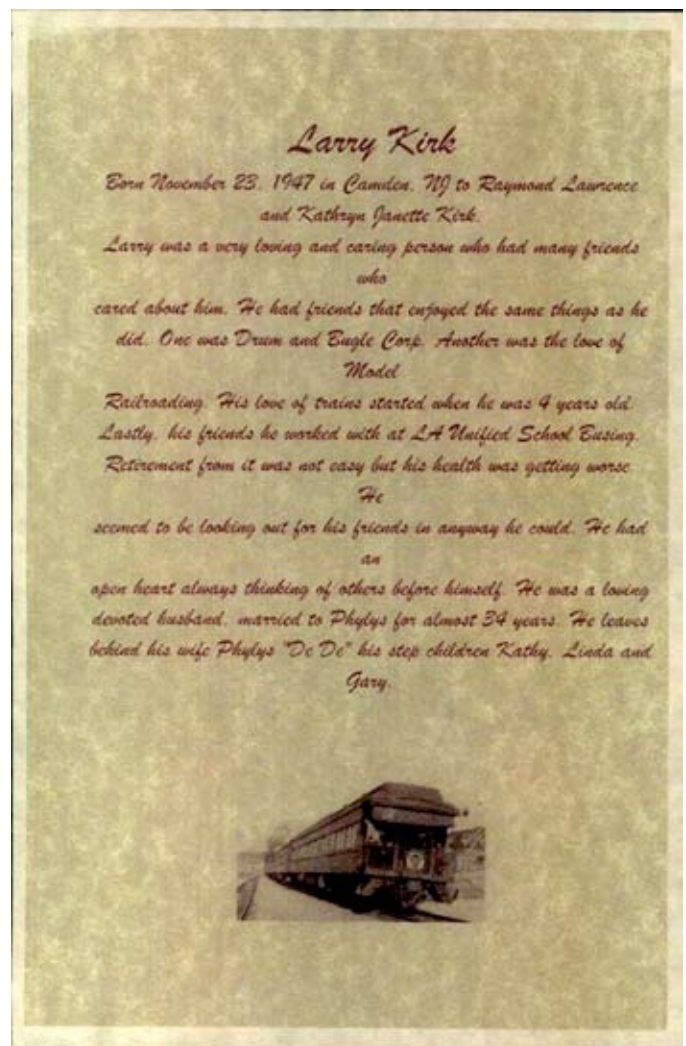
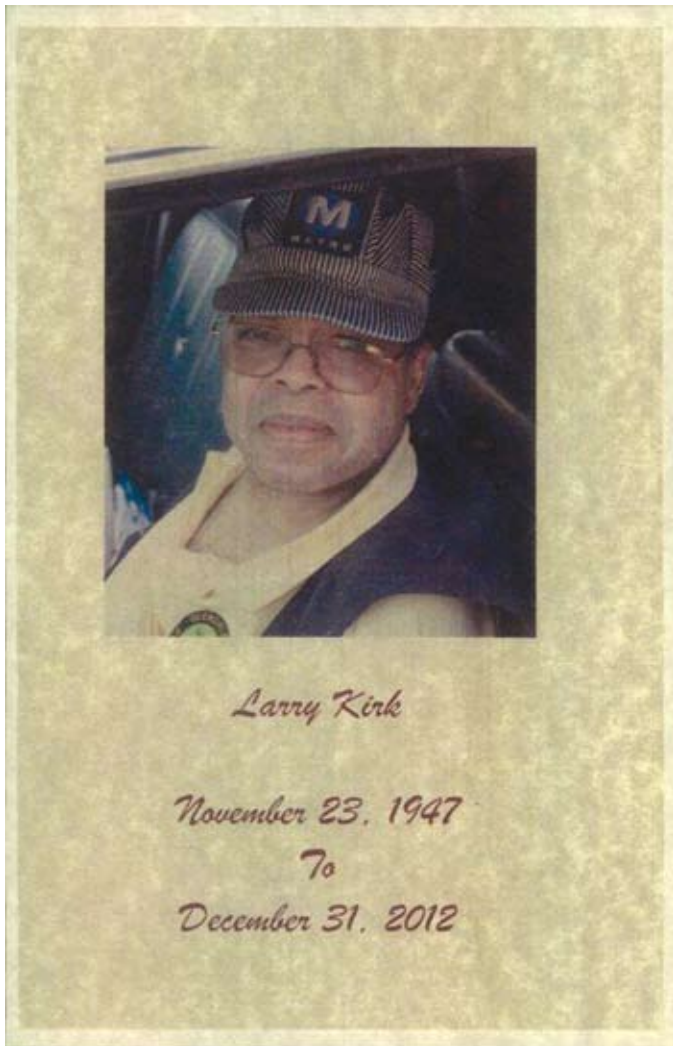
### Bay Window Caboose Souvenir Car
