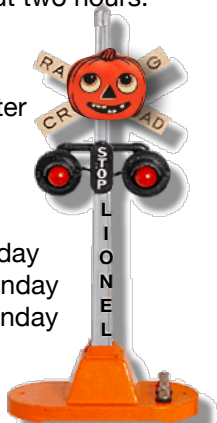
Admission is free for Members and \$5.00 for the public. Kids under 21 are free with adult admission.

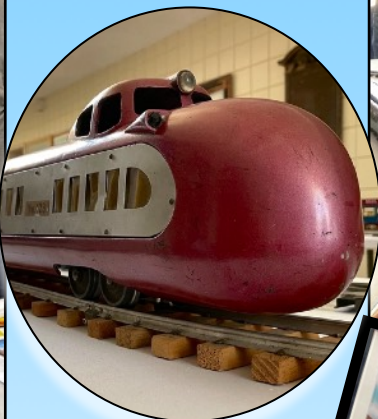

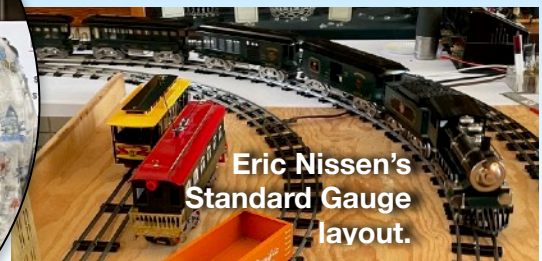

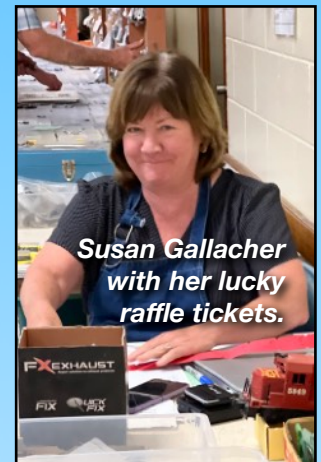

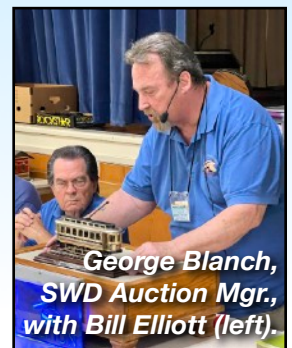
